

RESOLUTION NO. 13-025

WHEREAS, a firefighter has been suspended for thirty (30) days due to the loss of his driver's license; and

WHEREAS, a legal question has arisen regarding the duties and obligations of the Fire District when it comes to disciplining employees; and

WHEREAS, the Solicitor has recommended filing a declaratory judgment action to settle the rights and obligations of the Fire District in this regard;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners for the reasons set forth above that the Solicitor is hereby authorized to take any and all appropriate legal action, including the filing of suit, on behalf of the Fire District for the purpose of obtaining such declaratory relief; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Harrison Township Fire District is hereby authorized to implement this Resolution and execute any documents necessary in connection therewith.
