

RESOLUTION NO. 13-032
ACCEPTING THE DECISION AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE HEARING
OFFICER IN CONNECTION WITH THE DISCIPLINE OF WILLIAM S. BARNETT

WHEREAS, William S. Barnett, a part-time paid firefighter employed by the Harrison Township Fire District ("Fire District"), was charged with inability to perform duties, conduct unbecoming and other sufficient cause arising out of the loss of his driving privileges resulting from his guilty plea to driving while under the influence; and


WHEREAS, on May 31, 2013 an administrative hearing was held before Hearing Officer Todd J. Gelfand, Esquire; and

WHEREAS, the Hearing Officer rendered his decision dated July 2, 2013, wherein it was recommended that the suspension of Firefighter Barnett be upheld as sustained such that he be suspended for the ninety (90) day period of time or longer during which his driving privileges remain revoked and that he remain on suspension until adequate proof of restoration is provided;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners for the Harrison Township Fire District that it is hereby accepts the aforementioned decision and recommendation of the Hearing Officer such that William S. Barnett shall remain on suspension until such time as proof of restoration of his driving privileges is provided.
